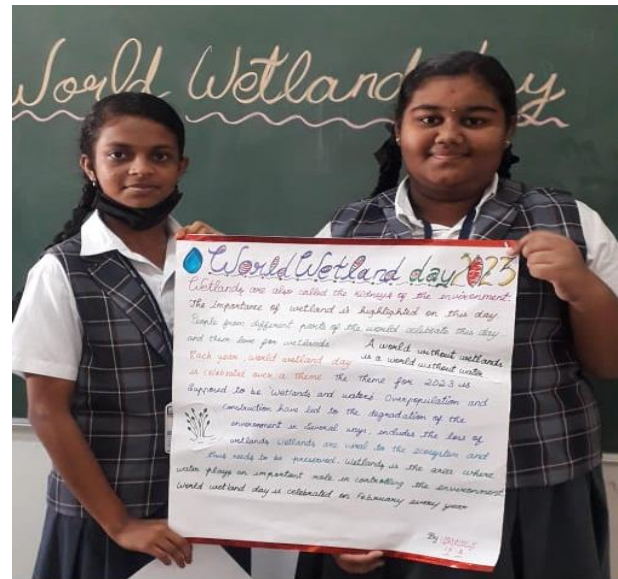

ANNUAL SPORTS DAY

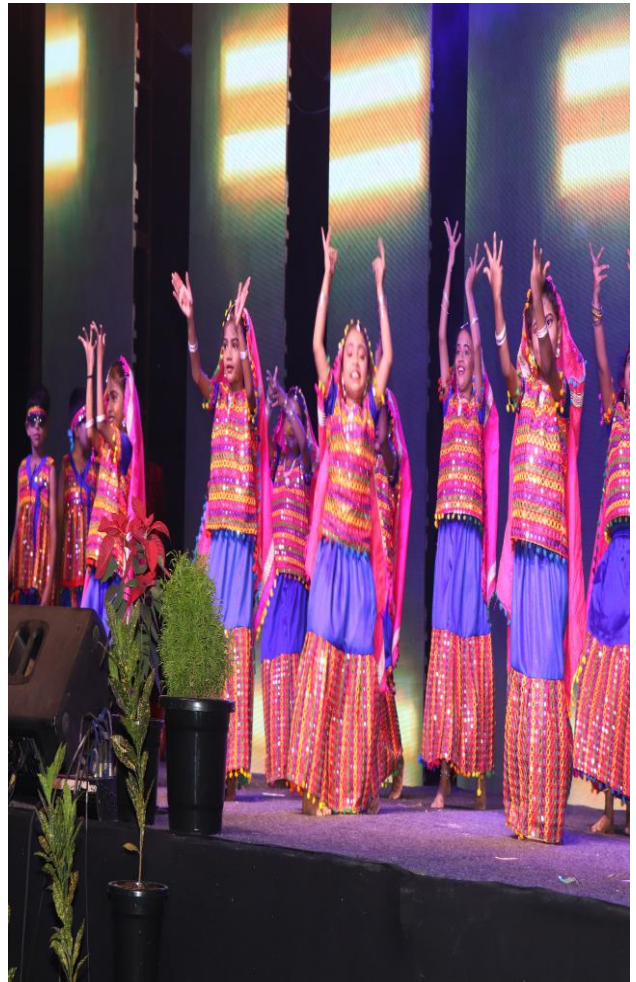
