National Girl Child Day.

The National Girl Child Day is celebrated in India every year on January 24. It was initiated in 2008 by the Ministry of Women and Child Development and the government of India, to spread public awareness about inequities that girls face in Indian society. The day is celebrated with organized programs including awareness Campaigns about Save the Girl Child, child sex ratios, and the creation of a healthy and safe environment for girls. Students of class 7 performed a skit based on the topic importance of girl child education.



Lala Lajpat Rai

The Birth anniversary of Lala Lajpat Rai was observed on 30th January (he was born on 28th January). Lajpat Rai was an Indian author, freedom fighter, and politician. He played a vital role in the Indian Independence movement. He was popularly known as Punjab Kesari. He is also known as 'the 'Lion of Punjab''. He died of a severe head injury after 18 days of trauma injuries during a baton charge by police in Lahore, when he led a peaceful protest march against the Indian constitutional reforms. Students of class 9 performed the same and delivered a wonderful speech.



Indian Army Day:

India celebrates Army Day on January 15 every year to commemorate the achievements of the first Indian Commander in Chief of the Indian Army — General (later Field Marshal) K.M. Cariappa. Children of class III and IV displayed the charts on Indian army day. Every year this day is celebrated on 15th January. They gave speech about the importance of Army and the significance of this day was elaborated.



Pongal Celebration

Pongal is also celebrated as a thanksgiving festival for various Hindu deities. The kindergarten of SBIOAIS celebrated Pongal fest on 13 th of the month. The festival of Pongal is held dear particularly by the farming community as it marks the end of harvesting season. The little ones brought messages of celebrating `Bhogi` and the first day is considered to be a prelude to the celebrations that follow, which is also observed as a thanksgiving occasion to Lord `Indra`, the God of Heavens. The next day is the `Pongal` day, which is celebrated to pay respects to `Surya`, the Sun God. It is the day of a new beginning and makes people go for joyful celebrations. As a mark of respect to the cattle, the farmer's best friends, the third day of Pongal festival is celebrated as `Maattu Pongal`. `Kaanum Pongal` marks the end of the four-day celebration. Children sparked the light through the colorful events like skit, dance and song. Department of kindergarten served sweet Pongal to all the children, teaching and non-teaching staff.
